WHAT IS THE ROLE?

- To plan and deliver Sunday services a few times per term that are suitable for all ages

WHY IS IT IMPORTANT?

These services allow the whole Church to meet and worship together in a way that builds community, grows faith corporately, and helps young and old to feel an important part of the Church family.

WHAT ARE THE BEST THINGS ABOUT THE ROLE?

- These services are creative and fun
- There is a rich sense of team work
- It is a chance to value our children in the main Sunday service

WHAT MINISTRY GIFTS & SKILLS DOES IT INVOLVE?

- Creative communication
- Administration – being organised
- Teaching & An ability to present spiritual truths so that children and adults can relate to them
- Leading services in a high-energy way
- Music
- Drama & Puppets

WHAT DO I DO SPECIFICALLY?

- When there is an all age worship service, you would meet a few weeks prior with the All Age coordinator (currently Jill Ward) for planning
- Depending on how you want to serve, you may be asked to write a script, create some prayers, devise a quiz or set-up a craft

HOW MUCH TIME DOES IT INVOLVE AND WHEN?

- 1 hour with the planning team before the Sunday service (usually 2 per term)
- 45 mins for the actual service
- Preparation on your own could take anything from 30 minutes to a whole day
